
Working Rule 21 Accident and Death Benefits


The Joint Secretaries for the Construction Industry Joint Council confirm that with effect from Monday 7th January 2013 the schedule of accident cover entitlements shall be increased in accordance with the table below:-

<u>Claim Type</u>	<u>Cover</u>
Qualifying claims	
Loss of Sight in both eyes	£25,000
Loss of Sight in one eye	£10,000
Loss of Hearing in one ear	£3,000
Loss of Hearing in both ears	£10,000
Loss by amputation or the permanent loss of use of:	
An entire hand or foot (below the elbow or knee)	£25,000
An entire arm or leg (at or above the elbow or knee)	£25,000
Big Toe	£1,300
Any other toe	£600
Thumb	£4,000
Index finger (loss of at least one joint)	£4,000
Any other finger (loss of at least one joint)	£800
Total Disablement:	
12 Months	£3,000
24 Months	£3,000
Permanent	£15,000
Maximum benefit payable	£25,000

The above is an insured entitlement from day 1 of employment and provided through B&CE Benefits Schemes by a premium paid by the employer and part of an overall accident and death benefits package. Accident cover is for accidents that occur either at work or travelling to or from work.

Death benefit is £25,000 and provided on a 24/7 basis with the cover doubled to £50,000 if death occurs either at work or travelling to or from work.
