There have been several pieces of environmental legislation introduced since the last update, some are new and some revoke and replace earlier legislation. Almost all deal with specific aspects rather than changing the regulatory framework. The exception is the Regulatory Reform (Scotland) Act 2014 which introduces Fixed and Variable Monetary Penalties and Enforcement Undertakings in Scotland and which will be available to SEPA once the necessary Orders have been made.

Other amendments include:

- New references to the revised ISO 14001 due shortly and to the BREEAM Refurbishment and Fit-out recently introduced
- Ecology – new information on biosecurity and elements of the new Infrastructure Act controlling invasive species
- Nuisance – new case study added in which it was held that compliance with an environmental permit may not provide a defence to a claim of nuisance.
- Waste – the Environment Agency Position Statements are now grouped together and include a new one on the use of manufactured topsoil
- Energy, Climate Change, & Greenhouse Gas Mitigation - revised section on delivering energy efficiency during construction and in the permanent works
- Water - minor changes including updating geographical areas of responsibility for marine regulation and the regulatory position statement on discharging water pumped from excavations.

The Manual is aimed at site managers and supervisors of main contractors and subcontractors, in particular it should help project managers, site agents, site foremen and engineers address environmental issues in a practical way. The Manual outlines the principal applicable legislation, details what must be done in order to comply, describes best practice both in the planning and construction phases and is packed with practical real-life onsite examples.
